Refund Rules MBA & HR: If a student chooses to withdraw from the program of study in which he / she is enrolled, the institution shall follow the following five-tier system for the refund of fees* remitted by the student.

Sr. No.	Percentage of Refund of Aggregate fees*	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is served to the Institute
(1)	100%	15 days or more before the formally-notified last date of admission (on or before 8th June 2020)
(2)	90%	Less than 15 days before the formally-notified last date of admission. (i.e. from 9th June 2020 to 24th June 2020)
(3)	80%	15 days or less after the formally-notified last date of admission (i.e. from 25th June 2020 to 9th July 2020)
(4)	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days, after formally-notified last date of admission (i.e. 10th July 2020 to 24th July 2020)
(5)	00%	More than 30 days after formally-notified last date of admission (i.e. from 25th July, 2020 onwards)

In case of (1) in the table above, the HEI concerned shall deduct an amount not more than 5% of the fees paid by the student, subject to a maximum of Rs. 5,000/- as processing charges from the refundable amount.

Sr. No.	Percentage of Refund of Fees*	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is received in the Higher Educational Institutions (HEI)
(1)	100%	15 days or more before the formally-notified last date of admission (on or before 10th June 2020)
(2)	90%	Less than 15 days before the formally-notified last date of admission (11th June 2020 to 26th June 2020)
(3)	80%	15 days or less after the formally-notified last date of admission (27th June 2020 to 11th July 2020)
(4)	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days, after formally-notified last date of admission (12th July 2020 to 26th July 2020)
(5)	00%	More than 30 days after formally-notified last date of admission (27th July 2020 onwards)

In case of (1) in the table above, the HEI concerned shall deduct an amount not more than 5% of the fees paid by the student, subject to a maximum of Rs. 5,000/- as processing charges from the refundable amount.
