Refund Rules - MBA Pharmaceutical Management Program: If a student chooses to withdraw from the program of study in which he / she is enrolled, the institution shall follow the following five-tier system for the refund of fees\* remitted by the student.

Sr. No.	Percentage of Refund of Fees*	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is received in the Higher Educational Institutions (HEI)
(1)	100%	15 days or more before the formally-notified last date of admission ( <b>on or before 8<sup>th</sup> June 2020</b> )
(2)	90%	Less than 15 days before the formally-notified last date of admission. ( <b>i.e. from 9<sup>th</sup> June 2020 to 24<sup>th</sup> June 2020</b> )
(3)	80%	15 days or less after the formally-notified last date of admission (i.e. from <b>25<sup>th</sup> June 2020 to 9<sup>th</sup> July 2020</b> )
(4)	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days, after formally-notified last date of admission (i.e. <b>10<sup>th</sup> July 2020 to 24<sup>th</sup> July 2020</b> )
(5)	00%	More than 30 days after formally-notified last date of admission (i.e. from <b>25<sup>th</sup> July, 2020 onwards</b> )

In case of (1) in the table above, the HEI concerned shall deduct an amount not more than 5% of the fees paid by the student, subject to a maximum of Rs. 5,000/- as processing charges from the refundable amount.

Note: Candidates to refer Important Dates of the respective programme.

The above refund rules are as per University Grants Commission (UGC) notification on Refund of Fees and Non-Retention of Original Certificates of October, 2018 and are subject to revision as per UGC notification (as applicable). Please note the closure of admission/last date of admission as mentioned in the dates is Wednesday, 24<sup>th</sup> June, 2020.
